Farmhouse Bean Soup

Serves 6. Prep time: 15 minutes active; 45 minutes total.

- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 yellow onion, diced
- 1 large carrot, peeled and diced
- 3 parsnips, peeled and diced
- 3 cloves garlic, peeled and minced
- 1 15-ounce can diced tomatoes
- 4 cups vegetable broth

- 3 to 4 sprigs each of fresh rosemary and thyme
- 1 15-ounce can northern beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 15-ounce can pinto beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 15-ounce can kidney beans, rinsed and drained
- 5 cups fresh spinach, chopped
- Salt and black pepper to taste

In a large pot, heat the olive oil over medium-high heat. Add the onion, carrots, parsnips and garlic and sauté 5 to 7 minutes. Add the tomatoes, broth and herbs and bring to a boil. Add the beans, reduce heat to simmer and cook 20 to 30 minutes until vegetables are tender. Stir in spinach and season with salt and pepper to taste. Serve warm.

Chicken Gremolata

Serves 4. Prep time: 25 minutes.

- 1 large lemon, zest and juice
- ½ cup parsley leaves, lightly packed
- 2 cloves garlic
- 2 ½ teaspoons olive oil, divided

- Salt
- 4 medium boneless, skinless chicken breasts, trimmed
- Freshly ground pepper

For the gremolata, use a micro plane or the fine side of a grater to shred the zest from the lemon onto one side of the cutting board. Halve the rest of the lemon, and set aside. On the other side of the cutting board, mince the parsley finely. Chop the garlic finely, then combine the zest, parsley and garlic on the board and chop together to a fine mince. Transfer the parsley mixture to a small bowl or cup and drizzle 2 teaspoons of olive oil and a pinch of salt over the mixture; stir to mix well. If the mixture seems dry, add more olive oil to taste. Makes about ½ cup.

Place the chicken on a cutting board, drizzle with olive oil and rub to coat, then sprinkle with salt and pepper. Preheat a grill pan over mediumhigh heat until very hot. Place the chicken on the grill pan and let cook, undisturbed, for about 5-6 minutes. Carefully turn each breast and squeeze a little lemon juice over the top. Continue cooking for another 5-6 minutes, or until the chicken is firm to the touch and an instant-read thermometer inserted in the thick part of the meat registers 165 degrees F. Let the meat stand for a couple of minutes before serving.
